

De Pere High School Tennis Court Project:

To replace the damaged and unsafe tennis courts at De Pere high school with new courts to accommodate the increase demand from the local tennis playing community. This project will include 10 courts, four with metered lights for extended play, all equipment, fencing, spectator bleachers and landscaping.

The estimated cost of this project is \$700,000. A 501(c)3 non-profit entity has been set up to receive your tax deductible donation. Unified School District # 1 has budgeted \$50,000 for this renovation and several other significant donations, both corporate and personal have already been made to Redbirds District Projects, Inc.

History of organized tennis programs in De Pere:

- 1970 First tennis lessons at Legion and VFW parks.
- 1980 Construction of 6 outdoor tennis courts at De Pere high school.
- 1980-81 First girl's and boy's tennis teams at De Pere.
- 1998 Resurfacing of DPHS courts into 5 doubles and 2 singles format.
- 2007-08 First girl's and boy's tennis teams at West De Pere.
- 2008 Construction of 8 new tennis courts at West De Pere high school.

2009 Completion and Dedication of 10 new tennis courts at DPHS
